

Homework expectation for Maple class 23-24:

This half term (Summer 1) you need to complete 5 of the homework activities:

Animal adaptations

Choose an animal and research the adaptations it has to suit its climate.



Climate and culture

Research the cultural differences between people of two different locations.

For example, compare the Inuit people with the Maasai people.



Get packing!

Using your preferred art form; create a picture which shows the landscape of an area in a very hot or cold climate.



Holiday advert

Write an advertisement poster or brochure for a hot or cold holiday destination. What activities can tourists do in that climate?



Postcard pals

Choose a destination (somewhere you have been before or somewhere you want to go). Write a postcard to Miss Thorpe. Tell her about the weather and climate and how that effects the clothes you wear, things you do and plants/animals you see.

Climate change

Research the effects of climate change. Create a poster, poem, song, artwork, leaflet etc. to communicate what climate change is, and how it effects the planet.



Homework must be submitted each week on a Friday. It will be checked and returned ASAP. If you have any queries about homework please contact Miss Thorpe.

You can present your work in any way you like, but please take your time to ensure you have completed your work to the best of your ability, that you include everything asked of you and that it is presented neatly to a high standard.
