

Homework expectation for Maple class 23-24:

Reading for 10 minutes a day

Times table practice 5 minutes a day

No more than 30 minutes of Mathematics per week

30 minutes a week on a selected homework task

This half term (Spring 2) you need to complete 5 of the homework activities:

<u>Communicating without sound</u> Learn a simple sentence or word to communicate using sign language. e.g. "Hello, my name is xxx" Write a paragraph explaining the importance of sign language.	<u>Junk Music</u> Using recycled material (with permission!) create your own musical instrument, create a poster to describe your instrument and the sounds it can create.	<u>Who's that composer?</u> Research famous musical composers and present your findings in an interesting way.
<u>What in 'ear'??</u> Create a model or draw a scientific diagram of the inner ear (human).	<u>My favourite song</u> Listen to your favourite song, while you listen write or draw how you feel. Feel free to use different art mediums and colour.	<u>Prove it</u> Conduct a scientific investigation to prove that sound travels in waves. Write up your findings.

Homework must be submitted each week on a Friday. It will be checked and returned ASAP. If you have any queries about homework please contact Miss Thorpe.

You can present your work in any way you like, but please take your time to ensure you have completed your work to the best of your ability, that you include everything asked of you and that it is presented neatly to a high standard.

Your project should be your own work (help from parents is fabulous and encouraged but the project is yours). Do not submit work copied straight from the Internet/ books (these are brilliant for research but please write in your own words).
