As well as completing your Mathematics homework and reading daily, please choose one piece of homework from this grid to complete **each week** and bring your completed work into school on a **Friday**. You can present your work in any way you like, but please take your time to ensure you have completed your work to the best of your ability, that you include everything asked of you and that it is presented neatly to a high standard. Get creative! Great examples of homework tasks will be celebrated in class and will be displayed in school.

Your project should be your own work (help from parents is fabulous and encouraged but the project is yours).

Do not submit work copied straight from the Internet/ books (these are brilliant for research but please write in your own words).

Write a recount of when you have visited a river. What was it like? How did you feel? Think about your senses in your recount.	Find out more about one animal or eco-system that is linked to rivers. If you are focusing on the Nile you may choose: Nile crocodile, hippopotamus, papyrus	Interview someone you know and talk about rivers; what is their favourite river? Why? What river animals do they know/like? Think of your own questions. Remember to use inverted commas and the correct grammar rules.
Create your own river collage (research an artist to inspire your design). Use whatever materials you like. Challenge; can you label key features and uses of a river.	Create a table to compare key information about the River Nile and another major river. You may wish to research one of these: Mississippi River Yangtze River Amazon River Ganges River	Create a map showing the key places along the River Nile. Can you identify where the river starts and where it ends? Why do you think people have decided to live along the river?
