Where did they believe they go when they die? What rituals did they practice?
Create an interesting picture (e.g., collage) of a Viking scene; stormy sea, long boat, a raid!	Write a diary entry for a Viking warrior or an Anglo-Saxon settler. Think about how a diary entry should be structured. Don't forget your capital letters, full stops and varied sentence structure.	Make or draw a Viking long house or long boat. Can you identify the key features of the structure/vessel?
