Think about and research what attracts tourists to volcanic areas. Create a tourist advertisement poster or leaflet for a real or fictional volcanic area. <i>Hint: look into Iceland or Hawaii.</i>	Research the clothing volcanologists wear at work. Design and label an outfit for a volcanologist. Consider materials and their properties.	Write a poem about a volcanic eruption or an earthquake. Use figurative language like: metaphors, similes, personification, alliteration and adjectives.
Find and compare the heights of different volcanoes. Present your findings in a table and a graph. Think about what type of graph would be most suitable for the data. <i>Hint: make sure your height data is in the same units!</i>	Sometimes our emotions can feel like an eruption! Create a poster of feeling management ideas for someone who may feel angry or upset.	Research the shape and structures of earthquake proof buildings. Design and build an earthquake proof structure.
